## School Uniform

Please can you ensure that your child is dressed each school day in appropriate School Uniform. Uniform for Nursery children is optional but many like to wear a school sweatshirt and have a book bag.

### **Ivy Road Uniform consists of:**

Burgundy Sweatshirt or Cardigan (with or without school badge)  
White Polo Shirt  
Black or grey trousers, skirt or pinafore  
Sensible Black shoes



### **In Summer:**

Red and white checked or striped dress for girls  
Black or grey shorts for boys

### **PE Kit:**

Navy blue shorts, white t-shirt and sandshoes



### **Miscellaneous:**

Ideally all pupils should also have a book bag  
**NO** jewellery to be worn except for stud earrings  
**NO** nail varnish to be worn  
Children should **NOT** bring toys into school

Please note that the school office has a **limited** supply of uniform in stock if you are unable to order online.
