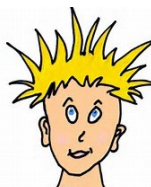

Year 6 with 98.21%

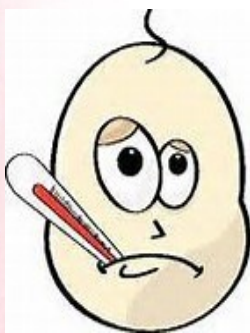
Week commencing 08/05/17 -
