



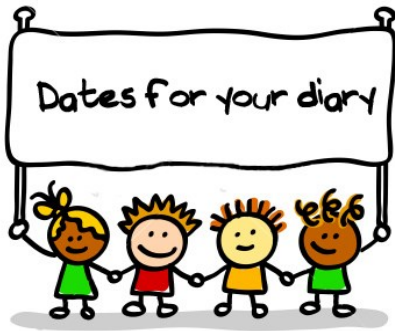

'Little Buds' - provision for 2 year old children

You will probably already be aware that from January 2018 we started offering FREE childcare for eligible 2 year olds (Little Buds). **We still have a few places available!!**

You can apply for up to 15 hours per week (for 38 weeks) of free early education and childcare, from the beginning of the school term after your child turns two.

If you or someone you know is interested, then go online and search for **North Tyneside Citizen Portal** and register to check if you are eligible or, if you need further support call 0345 2000 109. If you are eligible, you will be issued with a code which you will need to give to the school office.

If you are unable to go online, or struggling with registering, then please contact Mrs Latty in the school office who will be happy to assist you with your application.

'Little Buds' runs every weekday afternoon (term time) from 12.30 pm until 3.30 pm.

We are also offering places to 2 year olds whose families are not in receipt of benefits at a cost of £5 per hour. If you are interested in this, please contact the school.

Let your child join us to start an early education, make new friends and have lots of fun!



Attendance

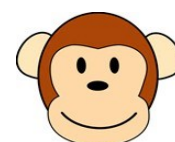
Attendance is monitored closely. Each week the class with the best attendance wins 'Popcorn' the monkey. List of winners:
