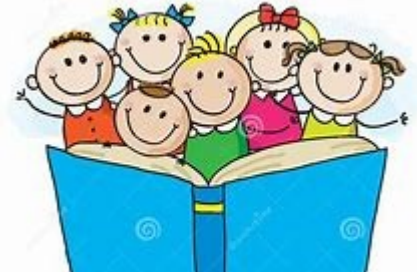

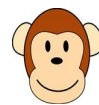
Attendance
