Children should bring a sun hat into school to wear at playtimes and lunchtimes and for outdoor PE.

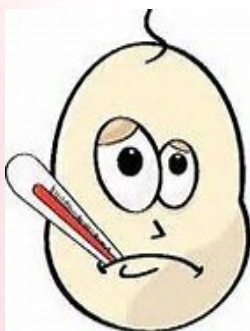
Children should bring in a refillable personal water bottle.
