Note to parents of children in Nursery

30 hours free childcare

You will probably be aware that our Early Years
Unit can provide 30 hours free childcare for
children in Nursery.

You will be able to check your eligibility using the online childcare calculator:

www.gov.uk/childcare-calculator and, if eligible, submit an online application.

Once signed up, you will receive an eligibility code to bring into school. We, as a childcare provider will then check the code with the Local Authority.

If you want your child to stay for 30 hours after the Easter holidays; you will have to apply for your eligibility code <u>before 31st March!</u>

Dates are correct at time of going to print but may be subject to change.

If your child is unwell and unable to attend school, it is essential that you telephone the school on the <u>FIRST</u> morning of absence and leave a message on the answer phone stating:

Your child's name Class

Reason for absence eg. vomiting, headache etc.

(Please do not just say that your child is not feeling well.)

It would be helpful if you could telephone again on <u>each</u> subsequent day of absence.

Attendance is checked on a regular basis by the Local Authority Attendance and Placement Office who will follow up any absence that is not accounted for. Absences without a valid reason will be marked as 'Unauthorised'.

A minority of our pupils are often late.


Please ensure that they are here on time and enter school through their designated door NOT via the school office.

- 5 minutes late each day works out at
 3 days lost over the school year.
- 15 minutes late each day works out at 10 days lost over the school year.
- 30 minutes late each day works out at 19 days lost over the school year.
