

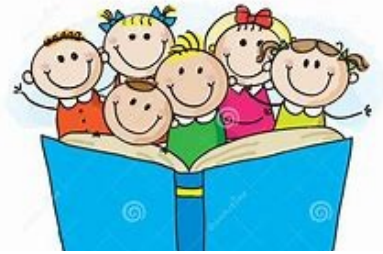


Ivy Road Primary School 2020 Newsletter

They can bring in their favourite bedtime book, to 'share a story' with children from other classes.

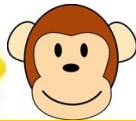
Children will all be given a £1 token to use against the purchase of a book.

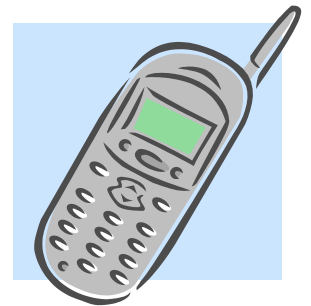
The Beetle Drive held on Thursday 6th February raised an amazing £188.38 towards school funds. Everyone who attended seemed to have enjoyed themselves.



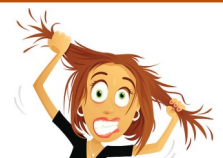
Are your contact details up to date?

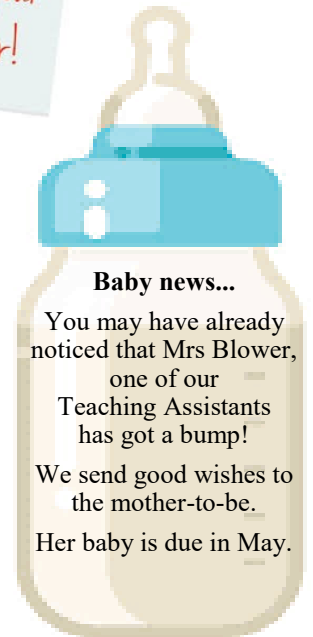
